**Public comment held:** Julie Wuerfel our present County Commissioner was present along with Don Meeks who will be our new County Commissioner due to redistricting and Joe Taylor who will be running for County Commissioner for our district in the November election. Julie updated us on the progress of Broadband internet coming to Sodus and that there are additional monies to apply for through ARPA grant monies through the County.

Lett Road- Pipestone Rd. to Tabor Road	\$15,223.00
Oxbow Rd.- Hillandale Rd. to Pipestone	\$14,120.00
Hartman Rd. - Hillandale Rd. to End	\$15,705.00

The total estimated cost for the eight projects minus matching funds will be \$277,671.00. Motion carried.
